A general plan is a State-law required long-range document that sets forth broad goals and policies to guide future growth and preservation of resources in the City. This document addresses a wide variety of issues such as the City's economic growth, physical development, and social well being. Once adopted, the General Plan is the principal tool for the City to use when evaluating municipal services and land use proposals. All land use and other decisions are governed by the General Plan and must be consistent with the Plan's direction.
